EVENT RULES

Loud n' Proud (Open Exhaust), Burnout Competition DEMO and Hot Wheels Racing

At <u>6:05pm</u> we will DEMO the events so everyone can see what we will be doing and understanding the rules and safety to these fun events.

LOUD AND PROUD (OPEN EXHAUST OR HEADERS) COMPETITION – Cars Must Be Street Legal – FREE

- Contestant must be registered in the show to be eligible. (Show Assigned Number#).
- Vehicle will be inspected prior to the event. Un-Safe vehicles will not be permitted to run until corrected. Please understand our concerns. Leaking gas or oil is dangerous.
- Must have a liability waiver signed at registration desk prior to event.
- Event will be demonstrated prior to the event for review and to avoid confusion or conflicts.
- At 6:15pm the announcement will be to line up for the competition. Go to the designated area.
- You will then be asked to move to the staging area. When you arrive, you will shut down your engine. Then wait to be called up to the starting line.
- Idle up to the area to be measured. The staff will measure the distance of 10' to the driver's side and 10' from the direct rear of the vehicle.
- You will be instructed to rev your engine for approximately 3 seconds, so we can get a meter reading at both locations.
- Please hold in the area for applause. You will then be directed to exit the staging area and park in the waiting area. This is just west of the staging area while the rest of the contestants compete.
- If you are one of the top competitors, you may be called back for a sound off. We will announce the return of any that were close to re-lineup. The staff will determine the closeness via decimeter readings of the sound. They will make a call there to continue the competition.
- Keep in mind this is a fun event. Open exhaust are illegal on the street but fully encouraged in the park boundaries. We are awarding a first place and runner up trophy this year and a gift certificate for the winner.

All participants will receive a (Special) Dash Plaque specific to the event.

BURNOUT COMPETITION - FREE

- Contestant must be registered in the show to be eligible. (Show Assigned Number#).
- Vehicle and tires will be inspected prior to the event. Un-Safe vehicles or tires may not be allowed to run until corrected. Please understand our concerns. Leaking Gas or Oil or Cracked Tires are Dangerous.
- Must have a liability waiver signed at the registration desk prior to this event.
- Event will be demonstrated prior to the event for review and to avoid any confusion.
- At 8:00pm the announcement will be made to lineup at the designated area.
- Lineup when called. You will be assigned a position at that time.
- You will move to the staging area and turn off your engine.
- Only when instructed to do so, pull forward in the zone outlined.
- You will be offered the option for water mix or not. Please indicate either way. It will be placed when you are in the area to begin. Please pay attention to the starter.
- Line locks or roll controls are preferred but not mandatory. Foot braking is allowed. If you waiver out of the zone outlined, you will be waived down to stop. **Again safety first!**
- When instructed, pull forward and you will be asked if you're ready. You will then start.
- You will have a <u>Max. 20 seconds to spin.</u> If you stop, no problem. You may start up again if you wish and continue for the allotted time. (We will not be roasting the tires until a blowout).
- Do not cross the finish line. Stop before it and gain control of the car. Let the smoke roll by and we will ask for applause. The event director will signal you to then exit.
- Keep in mind this is a fun event. How often do you get the chance to roast a tire or two and have a crown cheer you on? We are awarding the crown favorites this year with a nice trophy and gift certificate. We will also have a runner up trophy. Let's keep it a good friendly competition.

HOT WHEELS RACE

- Cars will be original, non-modified, non-powered Hot Wheels type vehicles.
- No Oil, Graphite, Silicone, or any other substance will be allowed.
- Any car that jumps the track is eliminated.
- All cars will be inspected at the time of registration.
- Cars must fit on a regular Hot Wheels Track.
- Age bracket groups will be as follows; 2-6 yrs., 7-10 yrs., 11-14 yrs., 15 and up.
- Prizes will be given to each bracket winner of each age group. 1st 6th place.
- Each bracket winner will have a chance to race the other bracket winners of each age group. This will determine the overall place champ. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc. up to 6th.
- Each overall place champ will have a chance to race each other to determine the overall grand champion.
- There will be a maximum of 36 cars registered for each age bracket.
- This is meant to be fun, non-competitive and all judges' decisions will be final.

If there is a malfunction or mistake made by the staff, we will try to accommodate. We reserve the right to have a run off or redo of any event. The show chairperson will make any final decisions.

Please be mindful of others while in a crowd. The park is a smoking and alcohol free zone. This is a free event sponsored by the city and our local businesses. If we make it successful we can grow bigger and better in the future.
